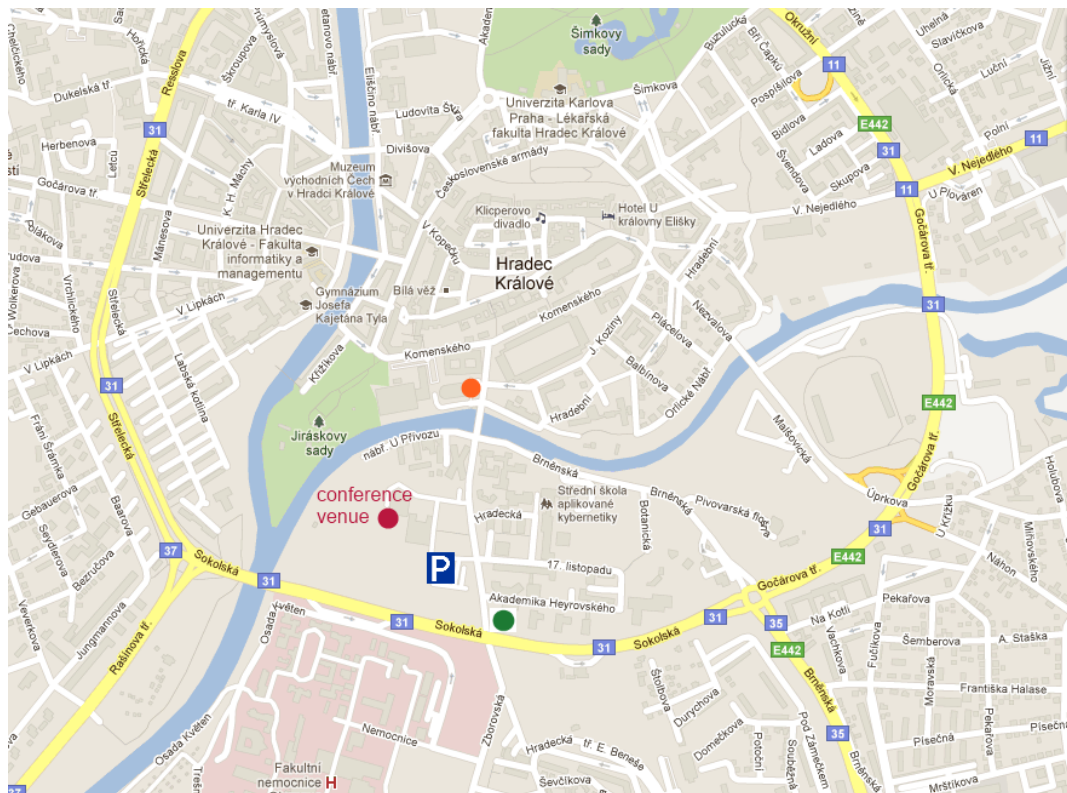

How to get there

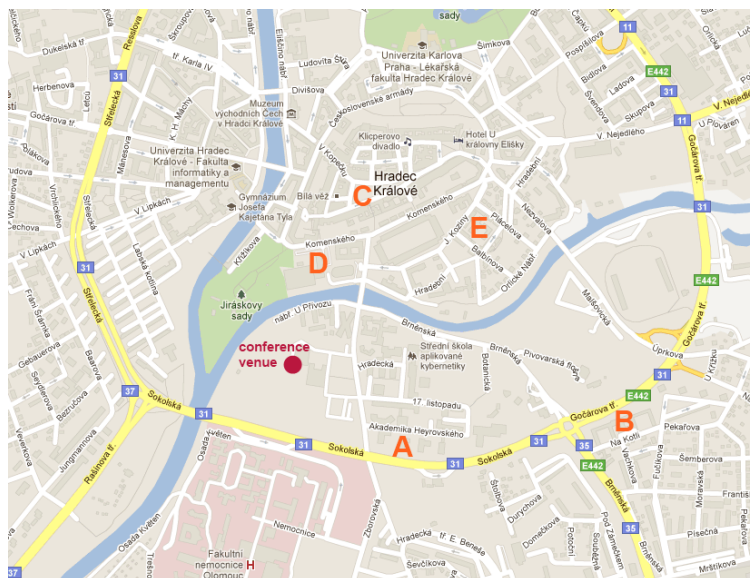
- **By car**
Drive to toward the town center until you reach the ring road (marked yellow in the map bellow) and after you drive across the bridge turn left at the first junction. On your left hand side there is a spacy parking place.
- **By public transport**
From the main bus/train station take buses 1, 9, 23, 24 or 28 and get off at „Heyrovského“ stop (marked with the green dot) and you will see the campus in front of you.
Or take buses 2, 16, 18, 23 or 27 and get off at „Zimni stadion“ stop (marked with the orange dot) and walk across the bridge, past University library („Swiss cheese type“ building) until you see the campus on your right hand side.
